Four years later, a trip was under taken to the place where he was born (Chisamba) by Chilenje Transient Home with the help Family Health Trust to trace his family. After a three-hour research, Chilenje Transient Home finally located his maternal family though his grandmother was not there.

Chilenje Transient Home (CTH) then left a message and directions to where the child was currently being kept so that the grandmother could follow-up the case but to date no such thing has been done.

Ben lived at the Transient home from the age of 11 months until the time he was 5 years old (6/06/2004).

From there he was transferred to Lifenet Children's Rescue Mission.

When he came to Lifenet Children's Rescue Mission, he was quite frail though talkative and it was thought he was not healthy and would be a sickly. Fortunately, it was discovered that he was strong boy. From the time he was adopted him there have not been any complicated health problems apart from the usual colds and coughs.

Ben has now been enrolled in grade 1 and would begin school in March this year. He has, however, proved that he has good learning abilities as he can speak some English and grasp things at a fast pace.

when he finishes school, though he seems a little bit uncertain but with time he would be certain with what he wants to be.

Sometimes he says he would want to be a pastor or a pilot. A very creative boy indeed
